You may shoot in more than one class if there is an open target in a 2nd relay. Class descriptions are in the club rulebook.  <b>Match Fees:</b> Member \$9, Non member \$10. Check schedule for dates &amp; times. Matches with drawing for benches will be one Hour before start. <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Bullseye Pistol</b></p> <p>Slow Fire: 2 series of 10 shots in 10 minutes at 25 yds.          Timed Fire: 4 series of 5 shots in 20 seconds at 25 yds.          Rapid Fire: 4 series of 5 shots in 10 seconds at 25 yds.  <b>Match Fees:</b> Members \$5, Non-members \$7          Match Director: Scott Gager ph 630-202-3545          email scottgager@hotmail.com</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>BARNYARD/CMP - Benchrest</b></p> <p><b>Barnyard Class:</b> A North American made .22 RF with original stock, barrel and trigger. Any type of action is allowed. The rifle must retail (as of 12/16) or have 1999 Blue Book (100% condition) for \$500 or less. Glass bedding, trigger job and re-crowning of barrel allowed. No barrel weighed prior to competitor's 1st 2010 Match. Winners will be spot checked. Scope must be 6.5X or less (variable OK if set at 6.5X or less). Ammo must have a list price of \$10.00 per 50 or less. No wind flags are allowed. Any sand bag style rests may be used. A front bipod may be used, but will be considered as part of the total weight of the rifle.</p> <p><b>CMP Class:</b> Any .22 RF target rifle purchased through the CMP (or civilian equivalent rifle). Above rules apply except: no weight restriction, no \$ limit on rifle and 12X or less scope (or variable set at 12X or less). Course of fire for each Class will be 3 targets with 20 record shots each, shot in 20 minutes per target at 50 yards. 6 targets may be fired on IR 50/50 &amp; RBA days to allow a shooter to shoot 3 BY &amp; 3 CMP targets or only 3 BY or only 3 CMP targets as they wish. A competitor may shoot targets in any order (BY or CMP first or may shoot only first or last 3 targets). Cannot shoot 6 BY or 6 CMP targets.  <b>Match Fees:</b> \$10 members, \$12 non-members for 3 targets (except for Nationals - 5 targets - \$25)          There will be Club Champion for highest score on a target for each class and one for highest average in each class (Best 4 matches of those entered will be used to compute average).
